## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the compilation and publication of information or
3	confirmed or probable cases of reportable diseases.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 81.047, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 81.047. EPIDEMIOLOGICAL REPORTS; COMPILATION AND
8	PUBLICATION OF CERTAIN REPORT INFORMATION. (a) Subject to the
9	confidentiality requirements of this chapter, the department shall
10	require epidemiological reports of disease outbreaks and of
11	individual cases of disease suspected or known to be of importance
12	to the public health. The department shall evaluate the reports to
13	determine the trends involved and the nature and magnitude of the
14	hazards.
15	(b) Based on the information included in the
16	epidemiological reports required by Subsection (a), the department
17	shall compile, aggregate, and publish on the department's Internet
18	website information on the number of confirmed or probable cases of
19	each reportable disease included in the reports. The case
20	<pre>information must be:</pre>
21	(1) aggregated based on:
22	(A) the reportable disease;
23	(B) the date each case of a reportable disease is
24	reported to the department; and

(C) the probable source of infection for each 1 case of a reportable disease; and 2 (2) updated <u>regularly</u> as <u>determined</u> by the 3 4 commissioner. 5 (c) During a public health disaster or public health emergency and based on the information included in the 6 7 epidemiological reports required by Subsection (a) for a reportable 8 disease related to the disaster or emergency, the department shall compile, aggregate, and publish on the department's Internet 9 website information on the number of confirmed or probable cases of 10 the disease, including the number of deaths caused by or suspected 11 of being caused by the disease. The case information must be: 12 (1) aggregated based on: 13 14 (A) the date each case of the disease is reported 15 to the department; 16 (B) the probable source of infection for each 17 case of the disease; and (C) the date of each death and total number of 18 19 deaths caused by or suspected of being caused by the disease; and (2) updated daily. 20 21 (d) In publishing information required under this section, the department may not disclose a patient's personally identifiable 22 information or information that is confidential under state or 23 24 federal law. SECTION 2. Section 81.047, Health and Safety Code, 25 26 amended by this Act, applies only to case information submitted on

or after the effective date of this Act.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
