- 8 State-Federal Relations is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset
- 9 Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter,
- 10 the office is abolished [and this chapter expires] September 1,
- 11 2035 [<del>2023</del>].
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 751.005, Government Code, is amended by
- 13 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 (b) The office shall:
- 16 (1) help coordinate state and federal programs dealing
- 17 with the same subject;
- 18 (2) inform the governor and the legislature of federal
- 19 programs that may be carried out in the state or that affect state
- 20 programs;
- 21 (3) provide federal agencies and the United States
- 22 Congress with information about state policy and state conditions
- 23 on matters that concern the federal government;
- 24 (4) provide the legislature with information useful in

- 1 measuring the effect of federal actions on the state and local
- 2 programs;
- 3 (5) prepare and supply to the governor and all members
- 4 of the legislature an annual report that:
- 5 (A) describes the office's operations;
- 6 (B) contains the office's priorities and
- 7 strategies for the following year;
- 8 (C) details projects and legislation pursued by
- 9 the office; and
- 10 (D) discusses issues in the following
- 11 congressional session of interest to this state; [and
- 12 [(E) contains an analysis of federal funds
- 13 availability and formulae;
- 14 (6) notify the governor, the lieutenant governor, the
- 15 speaker of the house of representatives, and the legislative
- 16 standing committees in each house with primary jurisdiction over
- 17 intergovernmental affairs of federal activities relevant to the
- 18 state and inform the Texas congressional delegation of state
- 19 activities;
- 20 (7) conduct frequent conference calls with the
- 21 lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of representatives
- 22 or their designees regarding state-federal relations and programs;
- 23 (8) respond to requests for information from the
- 24 legislature, the United States Congress, and federal agencies;
- 25 (9) coordinate with the Legislative Budget Board
- 26 regarding the effects of federal funding on the state budget; and
- 27 (10) report to, and on request send appropriate

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- 1 representatives to appear before, the legislative standing
- 2 committees in each house with primary jurisdiction over
- 3 intergovernmental affairs.
- 4 (f) The office shall post the report required under
- 5 Subsection (b)(5) to the office's publicly accessible Internet
- 6 website.
- 7 SECTION 3. The following provisions of the Government Code
- 8 are repealed:
- 9 (1) the heading to Subchapter A, Chapter 751; and
- 10 (2) Subchapter B, Chapter 751.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
