A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a grant program to provide free public school
- 3 prekindergarten programs to certain children who are eligible for
- 4 the subsidized child-care program administered by the Texas
- 5 Workforce Commission.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 29.1537 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 29.1537. PREKINDERGARTEN COMMUNITY-BASED CHILD-CARE
- 10 PARTNERSHIP GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The commissioner shall establish
- 11 and administer a grant program to support school districts and
- 12 open-enrollment charter schools in increasing partnerships with
- 13 <u>community-based child-care providers to provide prekindergarten</u>
- 14 classes under Section 29.153.
- 15 (b) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may
- 16 apply for a grant under the program in partnership with a
- 17 community-based child-care provider described by Section
- 18 <u>29.153(g)</u>.
- 19 (c) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 20 shall use money received under the grant program to fund the
- 21 enrollment of eligible children in prekindergarten classes
- 22 provided under Section 29.153 through a partnership between the
- 23 district or school and a community-based child-care provider
- 24 described by Section 29.153(g). A child is eligible for enrollment

- 1 in a prekindergarten class described by this subsection using money
- 2 received under the grant program if the child is:
- 3 (1) at least three years of age; and
- 4 (2) receives subsidized child-care services provided
- 5 through the child-care services program administered by the Texas
- 6 Workforce Commission.
- 7 (d) The commissioner may provide grants under the grant
- 8 program for the enrollment in each school year of not more than
- 9 3,500 children in a prekindergarten class described by Subsection
- 10 <u>(c).</u>
- 11 (e) The agency shall annually report to the legislature
- 12 regarding the number of children described by Subsection (c)
- 13 enrolled in a prekindergarten class.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 29.1537, Education Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
