- between a school district or open-enrollment charter school and a 13
- 14 community-based child-care provider described by Subsection (g);

- 16 (2) the child is eligible for subsidized child-care
- services provided through the child-care services program 17
- administered by the Texas Workforce Commission. 18
- SECTION 2. Section 29.153(b-1), Education Code, as added by 19
- this Act, applies beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. 20
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 2.4
