A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to baccalaureate degree programs offered by certain public
3 junior colleges.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 130.306, Education Code, is amended by
6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b) to read as
7 follows:

8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a [A] public
9 junior college offering a baccalaureate degree program under this
10 subchapter may not offer more than five baccalaureate degree
11 programs at any time.

12 (b) At any time, South Texas College may not offer more than
13 six baccalaureate degree programs under this subchapter, one of
14 which must be a bachelor of applied science degree in child and
15 family development.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
