5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 26.004(b), Education Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(b) A parent is entitled to access to all written records of
9	a school district concerning the parent's child, including:
10	(1) attendance records;
11	(2) test scores;
12	(3) grades;
13	(4) disciplinary records;
14	(5) counseling records;
15	(6) psychological records;
16	(7) applications for admission;
17	(8) health and immunization information;
18	(9) teacher and school counselor evaluations;
19	(10) reports of behavioral patterns; [and]
20	(11) records relating to assistance provided for
21	learning difficulties, including information collected regarding
22	any intervention strategies used with the child; and
23	(12) records relating to library materials checked out
24	by the child from a school library.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 26.006, Education Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 3 (f) Each school district and open-enrollment charter school
- 4 shall post on the home page of the district's or school's Internet
- 5 website a notice stating that a parent of a student enrolled in the
- 6 district or school is entitled to review the materials described by
- 7 Subsection (a)(1) and may request that the district or school make
- 8 the materials available for review as provided by this section.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 10 school year.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
