9	home visiting program. For purposes of this subsection, "minor"
10	means an individual who is younger than 18 years of age.
11	(e) A health professional or other person providing
12	services under the home visiting program must obtain the express
13	consent of the owner or adult occupant of the residence or property
14	before the person may enter the residence or property to provide
15	services under the program.
