- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the
- 9 exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from
- 10 the following provisions of this title:
- 11 (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an
- 12 open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D,
- 13 Chapter 12;
- 14 (2) Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that
- 15 a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and
- 16 Section 11.162;
- 17 (3) state curriculum and graduation requirements
- 18 adopted under Chapter 28;
- 19 <u>(4) Chapter 37;</u> and
- 20 (5) (4) academic and financial accountability and
- 21 sanctions under Chapters 39 and 39A.
- SECTION 2. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as amended
- 23 by this Act, applies only to a local innovation plan adopted or
- 24 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A local

- 1 innovation plan adopted or renewed before the effective date of
- 2 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the plan was
- 3 adopted or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 4 that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
