- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 752, Government Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 752.0535 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 752.0535. RETALIATION PROHIBITED FOR REPORTING
- 10 VIOLATION. A local entity or institution of higher education may
- 11 not suspend or terminate the employment of, or take other adverse
- 12 personnel action against, a public employee who in good faith
- 13 reports to an appropriate law enforcement authority the existence
- 14 of a policy, pattern, or practice of the employing entity or
- 15 institution that violates Section 752.053.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
