1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the consumption, possession, and sale of alcoholic
 1-22 beverages at certain performing arts facilities owned by certain
 1-23 school districts.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 11.179(a), Education Code, is amended to
 1-26 read as follows:

1-27 (a) The board of trustees of a school district may adopt a
 1-28 policy allowing the consumption, possession, and sale of an
 1-29 alcoholic beverage at an event held at a performing arts facility
 1-30 owned by the district if:

1-31 (1) the facility is leased to a nonprofit organization
 1-32 for an event not sponsored or sanctioned by the district; and

1-33 (2) the district is located in:

1-34 (A) a county:

1-35 (i) ~~(A)~~ that has a population of not more
 1-36 than 300,000; and

1-37 (ii) ~~(B)~~ in which a component university
 1-38 of the University of Houston System is located; or

1-39 (B) a county in which is located a facility
 1-40 described by Subdivision (1) within two miles of two or more
 1-41 stadiums with a capacity of at least 40,000 people.

1-42 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
