A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to public access to personal financial statements filed by public officials and candidates. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 572.032, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 6 7 follows: Financial statements filed under this subchapter are 8 (a) 9 public records. The commission shall: (1) maintain the statements in separate alphabetical 10 11 files and in a manner that is accessible to the public during 12 regular office hours; and 13 (2) make each statement available to the public on the 14 commission's Internet website not later than the 15th day after the date the statement is required to be filed or the date the statement 15 16 is actually filed, whichever is later. (d) The commission is not required to continue to make 17 available on the commission's Internet website a financial 18 statement that the commission may destroy under Subsection (c). 19 The commission may not make available on the commission's Internet 20 website a financial statement that the commission is required to 21 destroy under Subsection (c). 22 SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, 23 as amended by Chapters 34 (S.B. 1576) and 983 (H.B. 776), Acts of the 24

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85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted and amended 1 to read as follows: 2 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address, the 3 4 telephone number, and the names of the dependent children of an individual from a financial statement filed by the individual under 5 6 this subchapter before: (1) permitting a member of the public to view the 7 8 statement; providing a copy of the statement to a member of 9 (2) 10 the public; or 11 (3) making the statement available to the public on the commission's Internet website[, if the commission makes 12 statements filed under this subchapter available on its website]. 13 SECTION 3. Section 572.032(b), Government Code, is 14 15 repealed. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 16

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
