- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 59.05, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (h) Notwithstanding any other law, on dismissal of a
- 8 forfeiture proceeding under this chapter, or on the court's
- 9 determination that the property or an interest in the property is
- 10 not subject to forfeiture under this chapter, the court shall enter
- 11 an order requiring the law enforcement agency responsible for
- 12 seizing the property to reimburse the applicable owner or interest
- 13 holder for reasonable attorney's fees calculated in accordance with
- 14 the attorney's fees schedule promulgated under Section 72.039,
- 15 Government Code. If possible, notwithstanding the purposes for
- 16 which the money must be used under the law, the law enforcement
- 17 agency shall make the payment out of money available in the
- 18 applicable fund established for the law enforcement agency under
- 19 Article 59.06(c)(2), (3), or (4).
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 72, Government Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 72.039 to read as follows:
- Sec. 72.039. ATTORNEY'S FEES SCHEDULE. The Office of Court
- 23 Administration of the Texas Judicial System shall promulgate a
- 24 schedule of attorney's fees that may be used to determine a

- 1 reasonable amount of attorney's fees to award under Article
- 2 <u>59.05(h)</u>, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to property subject to forfeiture on the basis of an offense
- 5 committed on or after the effective date of this Act. Property
- 6 subject to forfeiture on the basis of an offense committed before
- 7 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 8 the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued
- 9 in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an
- 10 offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 11 element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
