A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the administration of assessment instruments on

- 3 religious holy days.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023(c-3), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (c-3) Except as provided by Subsection (c-7) or as otherwise
- 8 provided by this subsection, in adopting a schedule for the
- 9 administration of assessment instruments under this section, the
- 10 State Board of Education shall ensure that assessment instruments
- 11 administered under Subsection (a) or (c) are not administered on
- 12 the first instructional day of a week or on a religious holy day
- 13 including All Saints Day, Christmas, Diwali, Eid al-Adha, Eid
- 14 al-Fitr, Passover, Rosh Hashanah, Vaisakhi, Vesak, and Yom Kippur.
- 15 On request by a school district or open-enrollment charter school,
- 16 the commissioner may allow the district or school to administer an
- 17 assessment instrument required under Subsection (a) or (c) on the
- 18 first instructional day of a week if administering the assessment
- 19 instrument on another instructional day would result in a
- 20 significant administrative burden due to specific local
- 21 conditions.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
