## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the operation of a hospital at home program by certain
- 3 hospitals; authorizing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 241, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subchapter M to read as follows:

## 7 <u>SUBCHAPTER M. HOSPITAL AT HOME PROGRAM</u>

- 8 Sec. 241.401. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 9 (1) "Acute hospital care at home waiver program"
- 10 means:

- 11 (A) the program established by the Centers for
- 12 Medicare and Medicaid Services under 42 U.S.C. Section 1320b-5 that
- 13 waives the requirements of 42 C.F.R. Sections 482.23(b) and (b)(1);
- 14 and
- 15 (B) a successor program to the program described
- 16 by Paragraph (A) that is established by the United States Congress
- 17 or the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.
- 18 (2) "Hospital at home program" means a program
- 19 operated by a hospital to provide in a home setting health care
- 20 services that are considered to be acute hospital care for purposes
- 21 of the acute hospital care at home waiver program.
- Sec. 241.402. APPROVAL REQUIRED. A hospital may not
- 23 operate a hospital at home program unless the hospital is approved
- 24 to operate the program by:

- 1 (1) the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services;
- 2 and
- 3 (2) the commission under this subchapter.
- 4 Sec. 241.403. MINIMUM STANDARDS. (a) The executive
- 5 commissioner shall adopt rules establishing minimum standards for
- 6 the operation of a hospital at home program by a hospital.
- 7 (b) The standards established under Subsection (a) must be
- 8 at least as stringent as the standards established by the Centers
- 9 for Medicare and Medicaid Services under the acute hospital care at
- 10 home waiver program.
- Sec. 241.404. APPLICATION; APPROVAL. (a) An applicant for
- 12 approval to operate a hospital at home program under this
- 13 subchapter must:
- 14 (1) submit an application to the commission in the
- 15 form and manner prescribed by the commission; and
- 16 (2) pay a fee in the amount set by the commission under
- 17 Section 241.405.
- 18 (b) The commission shall approve an application submitted
- 19 by an applicant under Subsection (a) of this section if the
- 20 applicant meets the standards established under Section 241.403 and
- 21 satisfies the requirements of this section.
- (c) The commission may request that an applicant provide
- 23 additional information necessary to determine whether the
- 24 applicant meets the standards established under Section 241.403
- 25 after the applicant has submitted an application.
- Sec. 241.405. FEE. (a) The commission may establish a fee
- 27 to be assessed for the consideration of an application submitted

- 1 under this subchapter.
- 2 (b) The commission must set the fee in an amount that is
- 3 reasonable and necessary to cover the costs of administering this
- 4 subchapter.
- 5 Sec. 241.406. WAIVER OF REQUIREMENTS. (a) The commission
- 6 by order may waive or modify a requirement of a particular provision
- 7 of this subchapter or a standard established under this subchapter
- 8 if the commission determines that the waiver or modification:
- 9 (1) will facilitate a hospital's creation or operation
- 10 of a hospital at home program; and
- 11 (2) is in the best interests of the individuals who are
- 12 or will be served by the hospital's hospital at home program.
- (b) Sections 241.026(d) and (e) apply to a waiver or
- 14 modification under this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
