- 7 (k) Compensatory time off to which <u>an employee of</u> [a
- 8 correctional officer employed by] the Texas Department of Criminal
- 9 Justice is entitled under Subsection (f) must be taken during the
- 10 24-month period following the end of the workweek in which the
- 11 compensatory time was accrued or it lapses.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
