A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to compensatory time accrued by an employee of the Texas
3 Department of Criminal Justice.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 659.015(k), Government Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (k) Compensatory time off to which an employee of [~~a~~
8 ~~correctional officer employed by~~] the Texas Department of Criminal
9 Justice is entitled under Subsection (f) must be taken during the
10 24-month period following the end of the workweek in which the
11 compensatory time was accrued or it lapses.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
