- 8 SECTION 2. Section 162.003(a), Property Code, is amended to

- 10 (a) An artisan, laborer, mechanic, contractor,
- 11 subcontractor, or materialman who labors or who furnishes labor or
- 12 material for the construction or repair of an improvement on
- 13 specific real property in this state is a beneficiary of any trust

- 16 improvement; or
- 17 (2) reserved or required to be reserved under Section
- 18 <u>53.101</u> in connection with the improvement.
- 19 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 162, Property Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Section 162.034 to read as follows:
- Sec. 162.034. ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS. The court shall
- 22 award costs and reasonable attorney's fees to a beneficiary who
- 23 prevails in an action brought against a trustee under this chapter.
- 24 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
