- 6 SECTION 1. Section 102.07, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is

- 9 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), no [No] person
- 10 who owns or has an interest in the business of a package store or
- 11 wine only package store, nor the agent, servant, or employee of the
- 12 person, may allow an excessive discount on liquor.
- 13 (d) A permittee covered under Subsection (a) may offer
- 14 prizes, premiums, or gifts to a consumer. Except as provided by
- 15 Subsection (d-1), the [The] use of rebates or coupons redeemable by
- 16 the public for the purchase of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- 17 The holder of a winery permit may furnish to a retailer without cost
- 18 recipes, recipe books, book matches, cocktail napkins, or other
- 19 advertising items showing the name of the winery furnishing the
- 20 items or the brand name of the product advertised if the individual
- 21 cost of the items does not exceed \$1.
- 22 <u>(d-1)</u> The holder of a package store permit or wine only

- 1 purchase of alcoholic beverages; and
- 2 (2) provide a discount of any amount on the purchase of
- 3 liquor using a coupon redeemable by the public.
