H.B. No. 1980

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the procedures for the issuance of a personal
3 identification certificate to a person whose driver's license is
4 surrendered.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
7 by amending Subsection (m) and adding Subsection (n) to read as
8 follows:

9 (m) The department shall adopt procedures for the issuance
10 of a personal identification certificate to a person who surrenders
11 the person's driver's license at the time of applying for the
12 certificate. The procedures:

13 (1) must be in compliance with federal guidelines
14 governing the issuance of identification documents;

15 (2) may require the person issued a personal
16 identification certificate to update information previously
17 provided to the department under Section 521.142; ~~and~~

18 (3) except as provided by Subdivision (2), may not
19 require a person to provide additional identification documents
20 unless required for compliance with federal guidelines described by
21 Subdivision (1); and

22 (4) must require that the person issued a personal
23 identification certificate be provided a voter registration form at
24 the time of applying for the certificate to update the person's

1 voter registration information to include the identification
2 number of the newly issued certificate.

3 (n) If a person completes a voter registration form at the
4 time of applying for a personal identification certificate under
5 Subsection (m)(4), the department shall submit the completed voter
6 registration form to the secretary of state or the county clerk of
7 the county in which the person resides not later than the 30th day
8 after the date the personal identification certificate is issued.
9 Section 20.063(d), Election Code, applies to a voter registration
10 form described by this subsection.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
