9	eligible for a license as a massage establishment, massage school,
10	massage therapist, or massage therapy instructor if the person is
11	an individual and has been convicted of, entered a plea of nolo
12	contendere or guilty to, or received deferred adjudication for $\underline{:}$
13	(1) an offense under Chapter 20A, Section 22.011 or
14	$\underline{22.021}$ [Penal Code], or Subchapter A, Chapter 43, Penal Code; $[\tau]$ or
15	(2) another sexual offense.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
