## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 31.037, Election Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 31.037. SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT. (a)
7	The employment of the county elections administrator may be
8	suspended, with or without pay, or terminated at any time for good
9	and sufficient cause on the four-fifths vote of the county election
10	commission and approval of that action by a majority vote of the
11	commissioners court.
12	(b) The secretary of state may enter a written order to
13	suspend the employment of a county elections administrator at any
14	<pre>time if:</pre>
15	(1) an administrative election complaint is filed with
16	the secretary of state; and
17	(2) the secretary of state has good cause to believe
18	that a recurring pattern of problems with election administration
19	exists in the county served by the administrator, including any:
20	(A) malfunction of voting system equipment;
21	(B) unfair distribution of election supplies;
22	(C) errors in tabulation of results;
23	(D) delays in reporting election returns; and
24	(E) discovery of voted ballots after the polls

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 31.038, Election Code, is amended by
- 3 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c),  $a \in A$  vacancy in
- 6 the position of county elections administrator is filled by
- 7 appointment of the county election commission.
- 8 <u>(c)</u> A vacancy created by the suspension of a county
- 9 elections administrator under Section 31.037(b) is filled by
- 10 appointment of the secretary of state. An elections administrator
- 11 appointed by the secretary of state under this subsection serves
- 12 until the secretary determines that the recurring pattern of
- 13 problems with election administration are rectified.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
