- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 4151, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 4151.155 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 4151.155. APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN LAWS TO PHARMACY
- 8 BENEFIT MANAGERS. (a) Except as provided by this section, a
- 9 pharmacy benefit manager must comply with the provisions of Chapter
- 10 1369 with respect to each plan administered by the pharmacy benefit
- 11 manager, regardless of whether a provision of that chapter is
- 12 specifically made applicable to the plan.
- 13 (b) A pharmacy benefit manager is not required to comply
- 14 with a provision of Chapter 1369:
- 15 (1) with respect to a plan expressly excluded from the
- 16 applicability of the provision; or
- 17 (2) to the extent that the commissioner determines
- 18 that the nature of third-party administrators renders the provision
- 19 <u>inapplicable to pharmacy benefit managers.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, the commissioner of insurance shall repeal all rules
- 22 that are inconsistent with Section 4151.155, Insurance Code, as
- 23 added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. Section 4151.155, Insurance Code, as added by

- 1 this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan that is delivered,
- 2 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2024.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
