- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 52, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 52.060 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 52.060. TRANSCRIPT FEE EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN COUNTIES.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to a county that provides and
- 9 maintains court reporting equipment for a court in the county in
- 10 accordance with the county's established plan for the periodic
- 11 replacement of obsolete equipment.
- 12 (b) A county official or employee while transacting county
- 13 business is exempt from the payment of any fee authorized under this
- 14 chapter for issuance of a transcript of a case heard in a court for
- 15 which the county provides and maintains court reporting equipment
- in accordance with the plan described by Subsection (a).
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 52.060, Government Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, applies only to a fee for a transcript requested in
- 19 accordance with that section on or after the effective date of this
- 20 Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
