- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.0961(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A local government or other political subdivision may
- 8 not adopt an ordinance, rule, or regulation to:
- 9 (1) [prohibit or restrict, for solid waste management
- 10 purposes, the sale or use of a container or package in a manner not
- 11 authorized by state law;
- 12 $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ prohibit or restrict the processing of solid
- 13 waste by a solid waste facility, except for a solid waste facility
- 14 owned by the local government, permitted by the commission for that
- 15 purpose in a manner not authorized by state law; or
- (2) $[\frac{3}{3}]$ assess a fee or deposit on the sale or use of
- 17 a container or package.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
