## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the jurisdiction of a court in a suit to divide certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9.201, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- 8 the court that rendered a final decree of divorce or annulment or
- 9 another final order dividing property under this title retains
- 10 continuing, exclusive jurisdiction to render an order under this
- 11 subchapter to divide property not divided or awarded to a spouse in
- 12 the final decree.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 14 suit to divide property not divided or awarded to a spouse in a
- 15 final decree of divorce or annulment that is pending in a trial
- 16 court on the effective date of this Act or that is filed on or after
- 17 that date.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
