- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 7B.007(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A protective order issued under Article 7B.003 may be
- 7 effective for the duration of the lives of the offender and victim
- 8 or for <u>a</u> [any shorter] period <u>of not less than one year</u> stated in the
- 9 order. If a period is not stated in the order, the order is
- 10 effective until the second anniversary of the date the order was
- 11 issued.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 85.025(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, an order
- 15 under this subtitle is effective:
- 16 (1) for <u>a</u> [the] period <u>of not less than one year and</u>
- 17 not more than two years stated in the order [, not to exceed two
- 18 years]; or
- 19 (2) if a period is not stated in the order, until the
- 20 second anniversary of the date the order was issued.
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a protective order rendered on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act. A protective order rendered before the effective date of
- 24 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the order was

- 1 rendered, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
