## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the salary reclassification of certain positions with
- 3 the Parks and Wildlife Department.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The classification officer in the office of
- 6 the state auditor shall reclassify the following positions with the
- 7 Parks and Wildlife Department under the Texas Position
- 8 Classification Plan, 1961:
- 9 (1) the position of State Park Police Officer Trainee
- 10 (Cadet) shall be classified as a salary group C1 position;
- 11 (2) the position of Probationary State Park Police
- 12 Officer shall be classified as a salary group C2 position;
- 13 (3) the positions of State Park Police Officer I, II,
- 14 III, IV, V, and VI shall be classified as salary group C3 positions;
- 15 (4) the position of Sergeant shall be classified as a
- 16 salary group C4 position;
- 17 (5) the position of Lieutenant shall be classified as
- 18 a salary group C5 position;
- 19 (6) the position of Captain shall be classified as a
- 20 salary group C6 position;
- 21 (7) the position of Assistant Commander shall be
- 22 classified as a salary group C7 position; and
- 23 (8) the position of Major State Park Police Officer
- 24 shall be classified as a salary group C8 position.

- 1 (b) The classification officer in the office of the state
- 2 auditor shall change the occupational category of all state park
- 3 police officer positions to law enforcement.
- 4 SECTION 2. The changes made by the classification officer
- 5 as required by Section 1 of this Act apply beginning in the state
- 6 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2023.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
