(a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), to [To] be eligible to receive repayment assistance 8 under this subchapter, a mental health professional must: 9 (1) apply to the board; 10 (2) have completed one, two, three, four, or five 11 12 consecutive years of practice in a mental health professional shortage area designated by the Department of State Health 13 14 Services; and provide mental health services in this state to: 15 (3) recipients under the medical assistance 16 (A) program authorized by Chapter 32, Human Resources Code; 17 18 (B) enrollees under the child health plan program authorized by Chapter 62, Health and Safety Code; or 19 20 (C) persons committed to a secure correctional 21 facility operated by or under contract with the Texas Juvenile 22 Justice Department or persons confined in a secure correctional 23 facility operated by or under contract with any division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. 24

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1 establishes eligibility for loan repayment assistance under 2 Subchapter K, Chapter 61, Education Code, as amended by this Act, on 3 the basis of an application submitted on or after September 1, 2023. 4 A person who first establishes eligibility on the basis of an 5 application submitted before September 1, 2023, is governed by the 6 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the 7 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
