| 15 | (1) transfers within a state agency between two |

| 17 | (A) are allocated to the same salary group; and |
| 18 | (B) have the same position title as listed in the |
| 19 | General Appropriations Act; |
| 20 | (2) transfers to a position for which the employment |

| 22 | (3) voluntarily applies for the position to which the |

1 employee transfers at the publicly listed salary.

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 659.2532, Government Code, as added by
- 3 this Act, applies only to a transfer of position that takes effect
- 4 on or after September 1, 2023. A transfer of position that takes
- 5 effect before September 1, 2023, is governed by the law in effect on
- 6 the effective date of the transfer, and the former law is continued
- 7 in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
