A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to tuition and fee exemptions for firefighters enrolled in

- 3 certain courses at public institutions of higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.353(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 8 education shall exempt from the payment of tuition and laboratory
- 9 fees any student enrolled in one or more courses offered as part of
- 10 a fire science curriculum who:
- 11 (1) is employed as a firefighter by a political
- 12 subdivision of this state; or
- 13 (2) is a member in good standing of a volunteer fire
- 14 department that is registered with the Texas A&M Forest Service and
- 15 responds to 9-1-1 emergency calls in a designated area [currently,
- 16 and has been for at least one year, an active member of an organized
- 17 volunteer fire department participating in the Texas Emergency
- 18 Services Retirement System or a retirement system established under
- 19 the Texas Local Fire Fighters Retirement Act (Article 6243e,
- 20 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) and who:
- 21 (A) attends at least 20 hours of annual training
- 22 approved by the State Firefighters' and Fire Marshals' Association
- 23 of Texas;
- 24 (B) attends or provides support services for at

- 1 least 25 percent of the department's emergencies in a calendar
- 2 year; and
- 3 <u>(C)</u> holds:
- 4 (i) [(A)] an Accredited Advanced level of
- 5 certification, or an equivalent successor certification, under the
- 6 State <u>Firefighters'</u> [<u>Firemen's</u>] and Fire Marshals' Association of
- 7 Texas volunteer certification program; or
- 8 $\underline{\text{(ii)}}$ [\(\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{)}}\) Phase V (Firefighter II)
- 9 certification, or an equivalent successor certification, under the
- 10 Texas Commission on Fire Protection's voluntary certification
- 11 program under Section 419.071, Government Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 54.353(a), Education Code, as amended by
- 13 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and laboratory fees
- 14 charged for the 2023 fall semester. Tuition and laboratory fees
- 15 charged for an academic period before that semester are covered by
- 16 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
