1-17 relating to designating March 4 as COVID-19 Heroes and Memorial
 1-18 Day.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
 1-21 amended by adding Section 662.085 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 662.085. COVID-19 HEROES AND MEMORIAL DAY. (a) March
 1-23 4 is COVID-19 Heroes and Memorial Day in honor of people who lost
 1-24 their lives to COVID-19 and in honor of health care workers, first
 1-25 responders, and other essential workers who kept working during the
 1-26 COVID-19 pandemic so the public could stay safe.

1-27 (b) COVID-19 Heroes and Memorial Day shall be regularly
 1-28 observed by appropriate ceremonies and activities.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
