A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state to regulate greenhouse gas emissions in this state and the express preemption 3 of local regulation of those emissions. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 382, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 382.005 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 382.005. EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION TO REGULATE 8 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AND EXPRESS PREEMPTION 9 OF LOCAL REGULATIONS. (a) In this section, "greenhouse gas emissions" has 10 11 the meaning assigned by Section 382.05102. 12 (b) To the extent not preempted by federal law, the state has exclusive jurisdiction over the regulation of greenhouse gas 13 14 emissions in this state. (c) A municipality or other political subdivision may not 15 enact or enforce an ordinance or other measure that directly 16 regulates greenhouse gas emissions. 17 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20

Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
