The term includes an entity 7 [means a corporation] authorized by [a statute applicable to this 8 9 state or by] an equivalent law of another state or a foreign country [ rincluding a professional public accounting corporation 10 organized under The Texas Professional Corporation Act (Article 11 1528e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)]. 12 13 SECTION 2. Section 901.404, Occupations Code, is amended to 14 read as follows:

- Sec. 901.404. NOTICE OF LICENSE EXPIRATION. (a) Not later 15 16 than the 30th day before the expiration date of a person's license, the board shall send written or electronic notice of the impending 17
- license expiration to the person at the person's last known address 18
- or e-mail address according to the board's records. 19
- The board shall determine the amount of the renewal fee 20 (b) and shall provide written or electronic [mail] notice of that 21
- amount to the person within the time provided by Subsection (a). 22

- 25 SECTION 6. Section 901.054(b), Occupations Code, is

- 27 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
