- 14 not apply to an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(M)
- 15 [478.0001(3)(H)]. If an endorsing municipality or endorsing county
- 16 requests the office to make a determination under Section 478.0102
- 17 for an event described by Section
- 18 478.0001(3)(M) [478.0001(3)(H)], the remaining provisions of this
- 19 chapter apply to that event as if the event satisfied the
- 20 eligibility requirements under Section 478.0051(b)(1).
- 21 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 22 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023,
- 23 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 24 codes.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
