1-17 relating to computerized fee records in criminal cases.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Article 103.009, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
 1-20 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
 1-21 (e) An officer who has been provided a computerized case and
 1-22 financial management system by the county shall:
 1-23 (1) maintain the information described by Subsection
 1-24 (a) in the system; and
 1-25 (2) provide the complete computerized fee record in
 1-26 hard-copy form for purposes of satisfying the requirements of
 1-27 Article 103.001.
 1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
