- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 130.0107 to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 130.0107. CREDIT FOR COMPLETION OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT
- ASSOCIATE CREDENTIAL. In accordance with rules adopted by the 8
- 9 Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, a public junior college
- shall award at least six semester credit hours or the equivalent to 10
- a student enrolled in the junior college who holds a Child 11
- 12 Development Associate (CDA) credential.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 13
- 14 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18
- Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 19
