6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 502.062 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 502.062. REGISTRATION BY OWNER WHO TRANSPORTS
9	PASSENGERS WITH DISABILITIES. (a) In this section, "person with a
10	disability" means a person with:
11	(1) a physical, intellectual, behavioral, or
12	cognitive impairment;
13	(2) autism; or
14	(3) a health condition or disability that may impede
15	effective communication with a peace officer.
16	(b) An application for registration must provide space for
17	the applicant to voluntarily indicate that the applicant may
18	transport a person with a disability. The department may request
19	from a person who makes an indication under this subsection

(c) The department shall provide to the Department of Public

verification in the form of a personal attestation.

- 3 (d) The Department of Public Safety shall establish a system
- 4 to include information received under Subsection (c) in the Texas
- 5 Law Enforcement Telecommunications System for the purpose of
- 6 alerting a peace officer who makes a traffic stop that the operator
- 7 of the stopped vehicle may be transporting a person with a
- 8 <u>disability</u>.
- 9 (e) The Department of Public Safety may not make information
- 10 received under Subsection (c) available in the Texas Law
- 11 Enforcement Telecommunications System to a person who has access to
- 12 the system under a contract unless the contract prohibits the
- 13 person from disclosing that information to a person who is not
- 14 subject to the contract.
- 15 (f) The department may not issue to a person without the
- 16 person's consent a license plate with a visible marking that
- 17 indicates to the general public that the person voluntarily
- 18 indicated on an application under Subsection (b) that the person
- 19 may transport a person with a disability.
- 20 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (e), information
- 21 supplied to the department relating to a person with a disability is
- 22 for the confidential use of the department and the Department of
- 23 Public Safety and may not be disclosed to any person.
- 24 SECTION 2. A Department of Public Safety contract that
- 25 allows a person to access the Texas Law Enforcement
- 26 Telecommunications System and that is in effect before the
- 27 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the

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- 1 date on which the contract was entered into, and that law is
- 2 continued in effect for that purpose, except that the contract:
- 3 (1) continues only for the term of the contract; and
- 4 (2) may not be renewed unless the renewed contract
- 5 includes the prohibition required by Section 502.062(e),
- 6 Transportation Code, as added by this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
