4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 11.059, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows:
7	(e) Not later than December 31, 2023, the board of trustees
8	may adopt a resolution changing the length of the terms of its
9	trustees. The resolution must provide for staggered terms of either
10	three or four years and specify the manner in which the transition
11	from the length of the former term to the modified term is made. The
12	transition must begin with the first regular election for trustees
13	that occurs after the board adopts the resolution, and a trustee who
14	serves on the date the resolution is adopted shall serve the
15	remainder of that term.
16	(f) A resolution under Subsection (e) may only be adopted by
17	a board of trustees of an independent school district:
18	(1) with a central administrative office located in a
19	county with a population of more than 1 million but less than 1.25
20	million; and
21	(2) in which a municipality with a population of 4,500
22	or less is located.
23	(g) Subsections (e) and (f) and this subsection expire

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
