- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 552.0223 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.0223. DATES OF BIRTH AVAILABLE IN CERTAIN RECORDS.
- 8 Notwithstanding Section 552.101 or any other law, a person's date
- 9 of birth is not confidential and may not be withheld under this
- 10 chapter if that information is contained in:
- 11 (1) a candidate's application for a place on the ballot
- 12 that is required by the Election Code; or
- 13 (2) corrections or prosecutorial information,
- 14 including information regarding an arrest, charge, indictment,
- 15 conviction, order of deferred adjudication, or inmate record.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a request for information that is received by a governmental body
- 18 or an officer for public information on or after the effective date
- 19 of this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 20 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 21 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
