| 9 | commissioned as a peace officer by the comptroller is compensated |
| 10 | according to Schedule C of the position classification salary |
| 11 | schedule prescribed by the General Appropriations Act. |
| 12 | SECTION 2. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, is amended |
| 13 | to read as follows: |
| 14 | (a) This section applies to a peace officer under Article |
| 15 | 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is commissioned as a law |
| 16 | enforcement officer or agent, including a ranger, by: |
| 17 | (1) the Public Safety Commission and the director of |
| 18 | the Department of Public Safety; |
| 19 | (2) the Parks and Wildlife Commission; |
| 20 | (3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission; |
| 21 | (4) the attorney general; [or] |
| 22 | (5) the insurance fraud unit of the Texas Department |
| 23 | of Insurance; or |
| 24 | (6) the comptroller. |

- 1 SECTION 3. (a) The classification officer in the office of
- 2 the state auditor shall classify the position of security officer
- 3 or investigator commissioned as a peace officer by the comptroller
- 4 as a Schedule C position under the Texas Position Classification
- 5 Plan.
- 6 (b) The change made by the classification officer as
- 7 required by this section applies beginning with the state fiscal
- 8 biennium beginning September 1, 2023.
- 9 (c) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- SECTION 4. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, as amended
- 11 by this Act, applies only to an injury that occurs on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
