A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to an annual report regarding certain newborn screening
3	tests.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 33.020 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.020. ANNUAL REPORT. (a) For each newborn screening
8	test that screens for a disorder included in the list of core
9	conditions described by Section 33.011(a-1) that is not required by
10	the department, the department shall, not later than September 1 of
11	each year, prepare and submit a written report to the governor, the
12	lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
13	and each standing committee of the legislature having primary
14	jurisdiction over the department. The written report must:
15	(1) identify any additional program capacity or
16	resources the department would need to:
17	(A) implement the additional newborn screening
18	test; and
19	(B) require each newborn in the state to receive
20	the additional newborn screening test; and
21	(2) summarize the plan for implementing and requiring
22	the additional newborn screening test, including by identifying:
23	(A) any potential barriers to implementation;
24	<u>and</u>

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- 1 (B) the anticipated implementation date.
- 2 (b) As part of the plan described by Subsection (a)(2), the
- 3 report must include information on whether the department is
- 4 capable of implementing the required additional newborn screening
- 5 <u>test within a 24-month period.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 33.054, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 repealed.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
