A request for written consent under this 12 subsection: 13 (1) may not be included with any other notification or 14 request for written consent provided to the parent, other than the notice provided under Subsection (i); and 15 (2) must be provided to the parent not later than the 16 14th day before the date on which the human sexuality instruction 17 begins. 18 (i-4) A student who is homeless or in the conservatorship of 19 the Department of Family and Protective Services shall be provided 20 21 with human sexuality instruction unless the student's parent, guardian, or managing conservator, as applicable, requests in 22 23 writing that the student not be provided the instruction. 24 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
