relating to renaming the Texas Natural Resources Information System as the Texas Geographic Information Office and the duties of certain officers of that entity.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 16.017(b), Water Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The executive administrator shall operate as part of the Texas $\frac{\text{Geographic Information Office}}{\text{System}}$ a strategic mapping program to acquire, store, and distribute digital, geospatial information.

SECTION 2. The heading to Section 16.021, Water Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16.021. TEXAS GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION OFFICE [NATURAL RESOURCES INFORMATION SYSTEM].

SECTION 3. Sections 16.021(a), (b), (c), and (e), Water Code, are amended to read as follows:

- (a) The executive administrator shall establish the Texas Geographic Information Office [Natural Resources Information System (TNRIS)] to serve Texas agencies and citizens as a centralized clearinghouse and referral center for:
 - (1) natural resource data;
 - (2) census data;
 - (3) data related to emergency management; and
 - (4) other socioeconomic data.
- (b) The executive administrator may, on behalf of the Texas Geographic Information Office [TNRIS], enter into partnerships with private entities to provide additional funding for improved access to Texas Geographic Information Office [TNRIS] information. The board shall adopt administrative rules to describe the process of establishing partnerships, define the types of partnerships that may be formed, establish the fee collection process, and define the nondiscriminatory methods used to determine which private entities may enter into partnerships. Any process developed by the board must comply with all applicable laws regarding ethics, purchasing, and contracts.
- (c) The executive administrator shall designate the <u>deputy</u> executive <u>administrator</u> [<u>director</u>] of the Texas <u>Geographic</u> <u>Information Office</u> [<u>Natural Resources Information System</u>] to serve as the state geographic information officer. The state geographic information officer shall:

- 2-1 (2) establish, support, and disseminate authoritative 2-2 statewide geographic data sets;
 - (3) support geographic data needs of emergency management responders during emergencies;

- (1) further develop the Texas <u>Geographic Information Office</u> [Natural Resources Information System] by promoting and providing for effective acquisition, archiving, documentation, indexing, and dissemination of natural resource and related digital and nondigital data and information;
- (2) obtain information in response to disagreements regarding names and name spellings for natural and cultural features in the state and provide this information to the Board on Geographic Names of the United States Department of the Interior;
- (3) make recommendations to the Board on Geographic Names of the United States Department of the Interior for naming any natural or cultural feature subject to the limitations provided by Subsection (f);
- (4) make recommendations to the Department of Information Resources to adopt and promote standards that facilitate sharing of digital natural resource data and related socioeconomic data among federal, state, and local governments and other interested parties;
- (5) acquire and disseminate natural resource and related socioeconomic data describing the Texas-Mexico border region; and
- (6) coordinate, conduct, and facilitate the development, maintenance, and use of mutually compatible statewide digital base maps depicting natural resources and man-made features.
- SECTION 4. Section 16.023(b), Water Code, is amended to read as follows:
 - (b) The account may be appropriated only to the board to:
- (1) develop, administer, and implement the strategic
 mapping program;
- (2) provide grants to political subdivisions for projects related to the development, use, and dissemination of digital, geospatial information; and
- (3) administer, implement, and operate other programs of the Texas <u>Geographic Information Office</u> [Natural Resources <u>Information System</u>], including:
- (A) the operation of a Texas-Mexico border region information center for the purpose of implementing Section 16.021(e)(5);
- (B) the acquisition, storage, and distribution of historical maps, photographs, and paper map products;
- of historical maps, photographs, and paper map products;
 (C) the maintenance and enhancement of information technology; and
- 2-52 information technology; and
 2-53 (D) the production, storage, and distribution of
 2-54 other digital base maps, as determined by the executive
 2-55 administrator.
 - SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
