4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 38.158(b) and (e), Education Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall
8	require [approve for] athletic trainers to obtain continuing
9	education [training courses] in the subject matter of concussions
10	[and shall maintain an updated list of individuals and
11	organizations authorized by the board to provide the training].
12	(e) For purposes of Subsection (c):
13	(1) a coach must take a course described by Subsection
14	(a);
15	(2) an athletic trainer must take[÷
16	[(A) a course described by Subsection (b); or
17	$\left[\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{(B)}}\right]$ a course concerning the subject matter of
18	concussions that meets the [has been approved for] continuing
19	education requirements set [credit] by the Texas Department of
20	Licensing and Regulation under Subsection (b) [appropriate
21	licensing authority for the profession]; and
22	(3) a school nurse or licensed health care
23	professional, other than an athletic trainer, must take:

- 5 SECTION 2. Section 451.101(a-1), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) The department shall:
- 8 (1) [adopt an official seal;
- 9 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ prescribe the application form for a license
- 10 applicant;
- 11 $\underline{(2)}$ [$\overline{(3)}$] prescribe a suitable form for a license
- 12 certificate;
- (3) $[\frac{(4)}{(4)}]$ prepare and conduct an examination for
- 14 license applicants; and
- 15 $\underline{(4)}$ [$\underline{(5)}$] maintain a complete record of all licensed
- 16 athletic trainers[; and
- 17 [(6) annually prepare a roster showing the names and
- 18 addresses of all licensed athletic trainers].
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 451.153, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 451.153. APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS. (a) An applicant
- 22 for an athletic trainer license must:
- 23 (1) have met the athletic training curriculum
- 24 requirements of a college or university approved by the commission
- 25 and give proof of graduation; or
- 26 (2) hold a degree or certificate in physical therapy
- 27 and have completed:

- 1 (A) a basic athletic training course from an
- 2 accredited college or university; and
- 3 (B) an apprenticeship described by Subsection
- 4 (b)[; or
- 5 [(3) have a degree in corrective therapy with at least
- 6 a minor in physical education or health that includes a basic
- 7 athletic training course and meet the apprenticeship requirement or
- 8 any other requirement established by the commission].
- 9 (b) The apprenticeship required to be completed by an
- 10 applicant consists of 720 hours completed in two years under the
- 11 direct supervision of a licensed athletic trainer acceptable to the
- 12 department. [Actual working hours include a minimum of 20 hours a
- 13 week during each fall semester.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 451.156, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 451.156. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSE ISSUANCE. An
- 17 applicant for an athletic trainer license is entitled to receive
- 18 the license if the applicant:
- 19 (1) satisfies the requirements of Section 451.153 [or
- 20 451.154];
- 21 (2) passes the examination required by the department;
- 22 and
- 23 (3) pays the required license fee.
- SECTION 5. Section 451.157(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 25 to read as follows:
- 26 (a) The department may issue a temporary license to an
- 27 applicant if the applicant satisfies:

- 1 (1) the requirements of Section 451.153 [or 451.154];
- 2 and
- 3 (2) any other requirement established by the
- 4 commission.
- 5 SECTION 6. Section 451.154, Occupations Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
