Section 451.101(a-1), Occupations Code, 5 is 6 amended to read as follows: 7 (a-1) The department shall: 8 (1) [adopt an official seal; 9 [(2)] prescribe the application form for a license 10 applicant; (2) [(3)] prescribe a suitable form for a license 11 certificate; 12 (3) [(4)] prepare and conduct an examination for 13 14 license applicants; and 15 (4) [(5)] maintain a complete record of all licensed 16 athletic trainers[; and 17 [(6) annually prepare a roster showing the names and addresses of all licensed athletic trainers]. 18 SECTION 3. Section 451.153, Occupations Code, is amended to 19 read as follows: 20 Sec. 451.153. APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS. (a) An applicant 21 22 for an athletic trainer license must: 23 (1) have met the athletic training curriculum 24 requirements of a college or university approved by the commission and give proof of graduation; or 25 (2) hold a degree or certificate in physical therapy 26 27 and have completed:

1 (A) a basic athletic training course from an 2 accredited college or university; and 3 (B) an apprenticeship described by Subsection 4 (b)[; or 5 [(3) have a degree in corrective therapy with at least a minor in physical education or health that includes a basic 6 7 athletic training course and meet the apprenticeship requirement or 8 any other requirement established by the commission]. 9 (b) The apprenticeship required to be completed by an applicant consists of 720 hours completed in two years under the 10 direct supervision of a licensed athletic trainer acceptable to the 11 department. [Actual working hours include a minimum of 20 hours a 12 week during each fall semester.] 13 SECTION 4. Section 451.156, Occupations Code, is amended to 14 15 read as follows: 16 Sec. 451.156. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSE ISSUANCE. An 17 applicant for an athletic trainer license is entitled to receive the license if the applicant: 18 satisfies the requirements of Section 451.153 [or 19 (1)451.154]; 20 21 passes the examination required by the department; (2) 22 and 23 (3) pays the required license fee. 24 SECTION 5. Section 451.157(a), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 25 (a) The department may issue a temporary license to an 26 applicant if the applicant satisfies: 27

No. 2495 1 (1) the requirements of Section 451.153 [or 451.154]; 2 and 3 (2) any other requirement established by the 4 commission. 5 SECTION 6. Section 451.154, Occupations Code, is repealed. 6 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9

10 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
