Sections 451.001(1) and (3), Occupations Code, 4 5 are amended to read as follows: 6 "Athletic injury" means an injury sustained by a 7 person as a result of physical activity or exercise or the person's participation in an organized sport or sport-related exercise or 8 9 activity, including interscholastic, intercollegiate, intramural, semiprofessional, 10 recreational, and professional 11 activities. 12 (3) "Athletic training" means the form of health care that includes principles and methods for managing and treating 13 14 athletic injuries for athletic individuals in good general health [the practice of preventing, recognizing, assessing, managing, 15 treating, disposing of, and reconditioning athletic injuries] 16 17 under the direction of a physician licensed in this state or another qualified, licensed health professional who is authorized to refer 18 for health care services within the scope of the person's license, 19 and consists of: 20 21 (A) managing the risk of an athletic injury or 22 illness;
