A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to required lease terms for public property leased to a
- 3 nongovernmental entity; creating a criminal offense.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 2252, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2252.909 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2252.909. REQUIRED LEASE TERMS FOR LEASE OF PUBLIC
- 8 PROPERTY. (a) In this section, "governmental entity" has the
- 9 meaning assigned by Section 2253.001.
- 10 (b) A lease between a governmental entity and another person
- 11 regarding public property must contain lease terms requiring the
- 12 person to:
- (1) include in each contract for the construction,
- 14 alteration, or repair of an improvement to the leased property a
- 15 condition that the contractor:
- 16 (A) execute a payment bond that conforms to
- 17 Subchapter I, Chapter 53, Property Code; and
- 18 <u>(B) execute a performance bond in an amount equal</u>
- 19 to the amount of the contract for the protection of the governmental
- 20 entity and conditioned on the faithful performance of the
- 21 contractor's work in accordance with the plans, specifications, and
- 22 contract documents; and
- 23 (2) provide to the governmental entity a notice of
- 24 commencement consistent with this section at least 90 days before

- 1 the date the construction, alteration, or repair of any improvement
- 2 to the leased property begins.
- 3 (c) A notice of commencement under Subsection (b) must:
- 4 (1) identify the public property where the work will
- 5 be performed;
- 6 (2) describe the work to be performed;
- 7 (3) state the total cost of the work to be performed;
- 8 (4) include copies of the performance and payment
- 9 bonds required under Subsection (b); and
- 10 (5) include a written acknowledgment signed by the
- 11 contractor stating that copies of the required performance and
- 12 payment bonds will be provided to all subcontractors not later than
- 13 the fifth day after the date a subcontract is executed.
- 14 (d) On or before the 10th day after the date a governmental
- 15 entity receives an incomplete notice of commencement that does not
- 16 include the required copies of the performance and payment bonds,
- 17 the governmental entity may notify the leaseholder that the
- 18 construction, alteration, or repair may not proceed due to the
- 19 leaseholder's failure to provide the required copies.
- 20 (e) A person commits an offense if the person materially
- 21 misrepresents information in a notice of commencement. An offense
- 22 <u>under this subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. Section 2253.027, Government Code, is amended by
- 24 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 25 follows:
- 26 (a) If a governmental entity fails to obtain from a prime
- 27 contractor a payment bond as required by Section 2253.021 or fails

- 1 to include in a lease the lease terms required by Section 2252.909:
- 2 (1) the entity is subject to the same liability that a
- 3 surety would have if the surety had issued a payment bond and if the
- 4 entity had obtained the bond; and
- 5 (2) a payment bond beneficiary is entitled to a lien on
- 6 money due to the prime contractor in the same manner and to the same
- 7 extent as if the public work contract were subject to Subchapter J,
- 8 Chapter 53, Property Code.
- 9 (c) A governmental entity is not liable as a surety under
- 10 Subsection (a)(1) if a person leasing property from the entity
- 11 fails to submit to the entity the notice of commencement required by
- 12 Section 2252.909.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 14 a lease for public property entered into or renewed by a
- 15 governmental entity on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
