6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 410, Labor Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 410.008 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 410.008. CONFIDENTIALITY OF WORKING PAPERS AND
9	ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES AND APPEALS
10	JUDGES. The following working papers and electronic communications
11	of an administrative law judge or appeals judge created in
12	connection with conducting contested case hearings or appeals to
13	the appeals panel are not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552,
14	Government Code:
15	(1) notes and electronic communications recording the
16	observations, thoughts, questions, deliberations, or impressions
17	of an administrative law judge or appeals judge;
18	(2) drafts of a decision; and

- 19 <u>(3)</u> drafts of an order.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 21 document or electronic communication created by an administrative
- 22 law judge or appeals judge before, on, or after the effective date
- 23 of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
