## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the investigation of certain motor vehicle accidents.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 550.041, Transportation
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 550.041. INVESTIGATION BY PEACE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF
- 7 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 550.041, Transportation Code, is amended
- 9 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 (a) A peace officer who is notified of a motor vehicle
- 12 accident resulting in injury to or death of a person or property
- 13 damage to an apparent extent of at least \$5,000 [\$1,000] may
- 14 investigate the accident and file justifiable charges relating to
- 15 the accident without regard to whether the accident occurred on
- 16 property to which this chapter applies.
- 17 (c) An employee of a law enforcement agency who is not a
- 18 peace officer and who has successfully completed a training program
- 19 on investigating motor vehicle accidents that satisfies the
- 20 applicable requirements of Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, may
- 21 investigate a motor vehicle accident, without regard to whether the
- 22 accident occurred on property to which this chapter applies, if:
- 23 (1) no offense was committed during the accident other
- 24 than a misdemeanor punishable by fine only;

- 1 (2) no injury or death of a person occurred as a result
- 2 of the accident; and
- 3 (3) any property damage that resulted from the
- 4 accident was to an apparent extent of less than \$5,000.
- 5 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 550.062, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 550.062. OFFICER'S OR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
- 8 EMPLOYEE'S ACCIDENT REPORT.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 550.062, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 550.062. OFFICER'S ACCIDENT REPORT. (a) A law
- 12 enforcement officer who in the regular course of duty investigates
- 13 a motor vehicle accident shall make a written report of the accident
- 14 if the accident resulted in injury to or the death of a person or
- 15 damage to the property of any one person to the apparent extent of
- 16  $\frac{$5,000}{}$  [\$\frac{\$1,000}{}\$] or more.
- 17 (a-1) An employee of a law enforcement agency who is not a
- 18 peace officer and who investigates a motor vehicle accident in
- 19 accordance with Section 550.041(c) shall make a written report
- 20 summarizing the findings of the investigation.
- 21 (b) The report required by Subsection (a) or (a-1) must be
- 22 filed electronically with the department not later than the 10th
- 23 day after the date of the accident.
- 24 (b-1) If the motor vehicle accident involved a combination
- 25 of vehicles operating under a permit issued under Section 623.402,
- 26 the report required by Subsection (a) or (a-1) must include the
- 27 weight and the number of axles of the vehicle combination.

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- 1 (c) This section applies without regard to whether the
- 2 officer or law enforcement agency employee, as applicable,
- 3 investigates the accident at the location of the accident and
- 4 immediately after the accident or afterwards by interviewing those
- 5 involved in the accident or witnesses to the accident.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
