A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring training in the importance of mental and
- 3 physical health as a requisite for certain medical degrees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.312 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.312. MENTAL AND PHYSICAL HEALTH TRAINING REQUIRED.
- 8 (a) In this section, "medical school" means:
- 9 (1) a medical school as defined by Section 61.501; and
- 10 (2) any other institution of higher education, as
- 11 defined by Section 61.003, or school, department, or college of
- 12 such an institution, that awards medical degrees.
- 13 (b) Each medical school shall include training regarding
- 14 the importance of student, resident, and physician mental and
- 15 physical health in the curriculum required for a medical degree.
- (c) This section does not apply to the requirements for the
- 17 degree program of a student who entered the degree program at a
- 18 medical school before the 2024 fall semester. This subsection
- 19 expires January 1, 2030.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
